Duncan Aviation is pleased to present Citation "Super" II Serial Number S550-0119. Known as the S/II, N616TG has a pedigree shared by only a few. Since delivery it has lived in the United States, has been maintained by Factory or Factory Authorized Service Centers, and has been hangared each night. Moreover, Serial Number S550-0119 is a very well documented aircraft, with original logbooks going back to first delivery.

While the cosmetics on Serial Number 119 were last refurbished in 2005, discerning buyers will immediately take note that the present condition reflects exceptional care by recent owners. The interior of the aircraft includes a large forward two-place divan with under seat storage, as well as a belted lavatory seat approved for take-off and landing. This gives Serial Number 119 the capability of carrying ten (10) passengers in single-pilot operations. Serial Number 119 has extensive under-seat and galley storage for catering and service items, an enhanced private lavatory with sink and hot running water, and fully reclining and laterally tracking seats, all of which provide the necessary comforts when taking advantage of the aircraft's long range.

### The Citation S/II - Go Faster, Fly Higher, Go Farther

The Citation S/II was one of the first aircraft to benefit from Cessna's introduction of Computerized Aided Design (CAD). With its new "super-critical" wing, redesigned flight controls, and modified engine pylons, the S/II catapulted itself into position as one of the greatest single-pilot business jets of all time. The S/II has the speed, range, and altitude capability to reach both coasts from the US Midwest.

Serial Number 119 is perfect for both the experienced owner seeking the flexibility of single-pilot operations and the first time owner who cannot compromise between performance and economics.

#### INTERIOR

This stately nine (9) passenger executive interior was completely refurbished by Stevens Aviation in 2005. The interior is configured with a forward two (2) place divan with underseat storage, midcabin grouping of four (4) laterally tracking club seats with underseat storage, and two (2) forward-facing aft club seats. Midcabin clubs share right and left hand executive writing tables.

The aft private lavatory with sliding door features a fully flushing belted seat certified for take-off and landing, along with a hot water sink and ample storage space.

The forward refreshment center includes a hot MAPCO coffee dispenser, ice chest, and beverage service counter.

Crew seats are finished in Sheepskin. Cockpit accommodations include privacy curtain and pilot / copilot manual and chart case holders.


