INTERIOR

This aircraft has been well cared for, which shows especially in its interior. The interior soft goods were updated in 2017, featuring AMP series 900 seating upholstered in two-tone cream with chocolate accents. The forward cabin is comprised of four (4) executive club seats. The aft cabin is comprised of two (2) additional executive club seats along opposite a three (3) seat divan. These nine (9) main cabin seats are supplemented by an aft lav seat upholstered in light grey leather. The upper sidewalls and headliner are similarly upholstered in light grey ultra-leather. The cabin features medium tone cherry veneer cabinetry in a high-gloss finish, continuing through its spacious galley with plentiful storage and dual warming ovens.
